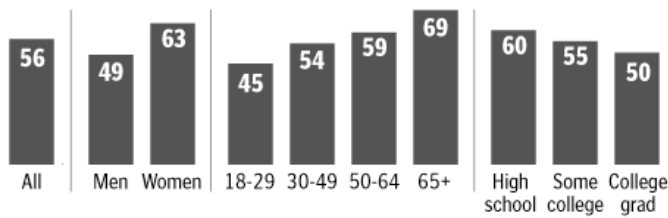

Pray or read scripture with their children:

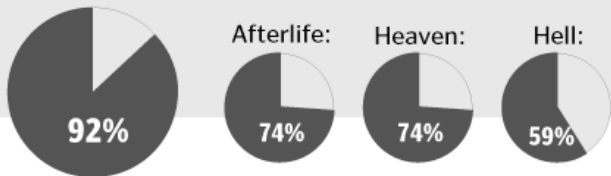


Speak or pray in tongues at least occasionally:



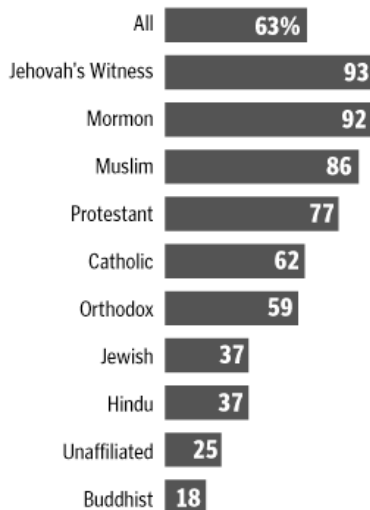
## Percent who believe in . . .

God or a universal spirit:

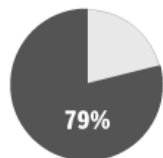

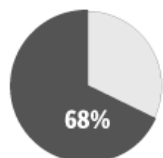
Percent saying their holy book is the word of God:
